The Administration is recommending that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to approve an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Salt Lake City and the State of Utah Division of Parks and Recreation. The agreement is for the transfer of State Park property along the Jordan River (including the Par-3 golf course) to Salt Lake City Corporation.

The City has included the operation of the property in the fiscal year 2003-04 budget. The City is already in control of these properties through a special use permit that was issued by the State Parks Division. As a condition of accepting these properties, the State has agreed to give the City \$60,000 annually for three years to help offset maintenance costs.

The only remaining action needed by the City and State is to have the State transfer the fee title ownership and annual operation funds. The final action will occur once the City adopts the proposed resolution and the cooperation agreement is executed.

As noted on the transmittal, the transfer of operations occurred without disruption to the users of the transferred property. The delay in transferring fee title ownership to the City has not resulted in any problems to the City or the public.
