AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 15.16
OF THE SALT LAKE CITY CODE, RELATING TO FEES FOR PARK AND
RECREATION FACILITIES, AND REPEALING CHAPTER 15.21 OF THE SALT
LAKE CITY CODE, RELATING TO THE RECREATION ENTERPRISE FUND.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Salt Lake City, Utah:

SECTION 1. That Section 15.16.031 of the Salt Lake City Code be, and the same hereby is, amended as follows:

15.16.031 Golf Courses-Green Fees:

A. Fees Imposed:

There are imposed on any person playing golf at any of the city golf courses the following fees.: The green fees listed in this section shall take effect on January 1, 2007. The season pass programs shall take effect immediately upon the date of the first publication of this ordinance. All fees include sales tax unless otherwise noted:

5. Grandfathered Senior Season Golf Passes:

In 1997, the decision was made by the Golf Division, with the approval of the City Council, to phase out the Season Pass program and to effectively grandfather the Senior Season Pass program for qualified Senior Season Pass holders based on their continued participation. Season passes for calendar years subsequent to 1997 were available solely to those individuals who had purchased calendar 1997 season passes on or before June 30, 1997. No other season passes were issued after this date. Season pass holders were required to renew their passes annually in order to remain eligible for a season pass. Any season pass holder who failed to renew a pass for any year would not be eligible for any further season pass. Season passes for individuals who were neither junior nor senior golfers were discontinued on December 21, 2003 and no season passes were issued for years after calendar year 2003.

In light of the implementation of the new season pass program detailed in this ordinance, Senior Season Pass holders who are still eligible to participate in the Grandfathered Senior Season Pass Program may elect to continue to participate under the same restrictions and guidelines.

Current Grandfathered Senior Season Pass holders must renew their passes annually in order to remain eligible for the Grandfathered Senior Season Pass Program. Any Grandfathered Senior Season Pass holder who fails to renew a pass for any year shall not be eligible to continue to participate in the Grandfathered Senior Season Pass Program. The use of funds collected via the surcharge shown below shall be solely dedicated to physical improvements at city golf courses. Grandfathered Senior Season Golf Passes may not be used Fridays through Sundays, on defined holidays, or for group reservation play. The following fees pertain to the Grandfathered Senior Season Pass Program:

9. Season Golf Passes: Season passes for calendar years subsequent to 1997 will be available solely to those individuals who had purchased calendar 1997 season passes on or before June 30, 1997. No other season passes shall be issued. Current season pass holders shall renew their passes annually in order to remain eligible for a season pass. Any season pass holder who fails to renew a pass for any year shall not be eligible for any further season pass. Season passes for individuals who are neither junior nor senior golfers will be discontinued on December 31, 2003, and no season passes will be issued for years after calendar year 2003, for individuals who are neither junior nor senior golfers.

As per the schedule in subsection A9b of this section, on and after January 1, 1998, a surcharge will be assessed on the date of play, on each round played using a season pass. a. Senior/junior rate, four hundred dollars (\$400.00).



B. Eligibility For Season Pass: Only persons whose principal place of residence is within the state and who, at the time of pass purchase, have a present expectation to continue residency within the state throughout the term of the pass, shall be eligible to purchase or use season golf passes.

12. Par Pass (Weekday 5-Course)

Golfers may obtain from the Salt Lake City Golf Division Administration Office a nontransferable season pass card called the Par Pass to be presented at the golf course in lieu of payment for green fees. This season pass is subject to the following terms and conditions.

a. The card may be used at any time Monday through Thursday and Friday until
Noon at the following courses: Forest Dale, Glendale, Jordan River Par-3, Nibley
Park, and Rose Park.

- b. The adult price for the card is eight hundred ninety five dollars plus tax (\$895+tax).
- c. The senior price for the card is seven hundred fifteen dollars plus tax (\$715+tax).
- d. The card is valid for one (1) year from the date of purchase.
- e. The card is not valid on holidays.
- f. The purchase price for the card and program availability are subject to change annually.

13. Birdie Pass (Weekday 9-Course)

Golfers may obtain from the Salt Lake City Golf Division Administration Office a nontransferable season pass card called the Birdie Pass to be presented at the golf course in lieu of payment for green fees. This season pass is subject to the following terms and conditions.

- a. The card may be used at any time Monday through Thursday and Friday until Noon at the following courses: Bonneville, Forest Dale, Glendale, Jordan River Par-3, Mountain Dell Lake, Mountain Dell Canyon, Nibley Park, Rose Park, and Wingpointe.
- b. The adult price for the card is one thousand ninety five dollars plus tax (\$1,095+tax).
- c. The senior price for the card is eight hundred seventy five dollars plus tax (\$875+tax).
- d. The card is valid for one (1) year from the date of purchase.
- e. The card is not valid on holidays.
- f. The purchase price for the card and program availability are subject to change annually.

14. Eagle Pass (Unlimited 5-Course)

Golfers may obtain from the Salt Lake City Golf Division Administration Office a nontransferable season pass card called the Eagle Pass to be presented at the golf course in lieu of payment for green fees. This season pass is subject to the following terms and conditions.

- a. The card may be used at any time seven days a week (including holidays) at the following courses: Forest Dale, Glendale, Jordan River Par-3, Nibley Park, and Rose Park.
- b. The adult price for the card is one thousand two hundred ninety five dollars plus tax (\$1,295+tax).
- c. The senior price for the card is one thousand thirty five dollars plus tax (\$1,035+tax).
- d. The card is valid for one (1) year from the date of purchase.
- e. The purchase price for the card and program availability are subject to change annually.

15. Double Eagle Pass (Unlimited 9-Course)

Golfers may obtain from the Salt Lake City Golf Division Administration Office a nontransferable season pass card called the Double Bagle Pass to be presented at the golf

course in lieu of payment for green fees. This season pass is subject to the following terms and conditions.

- a. The card may be used at any time seven days a week (including holidays) at the following courses: Bonneville, Forest Dale, Glendale, Jordan River Par-3, Mountain Dell Lake, Mountain Dell Canyon, Nibley Park, Rose Park, and Wingpointe.
- b. The adult price for the card is one thousand six hundred ninety five dollars plus tax (\$1,695+tax).
- c. The senior price for the card is one thousand three hundred fifty five dollars plus tax (\$1,355+tax).
- d. The card is valid for one (1) year from the date of purchase.
- e. The purchase price for the card and program availability are subject to change annually.

16. Junior Par Pass (May-August 5-Course)

Golfers may obtain from the Salt Lake City Golf Division Administration Office a nontransferable season pass card called the Junior Par Pass to be presented at the golf course in lieu of payment for green fees. This season pass is subject to the following terms and conditions.

- a. The card is may be used May 1 through August 31.
- b. The card may be used at any time Monday through Thursday, Friday before
 Noon, and Saturday and Sunday after Noon at the following courses: Forest Dale,
 Glendale, Jordan River Par-3, Nibley Park, and Rose Park.
- c. The card is not valid on holidays.
- d. The junior price for the card is two hundred fifty dollars plus tax (\$250+tax).
- e. The purchase price for the card and program availability are subject to change annually.

17. Junior Birdie Pass (May-August 9-Course)

Golfers may obtain from the Salt Lake City Golf Division Administration Office a nontransferable season pass card called the Junior Birdie Pass to be presented at the golf course in lieu of payment for green fees. This season pass is subject to the following terms and conditions.

- a. The card is may be used May 1 through August 31.
- b. The card may be used at any time Monday through Thursday, Friday before
 Noon, and Saturday and Sunday after Noon at the following courses: Bonneville,
 Forest Dale, Glendale, Jordan River Par-3, Mountain Dell Lake, Mountain Dell
 Canyon, Nibley Park, Rose Park, and Wingpointe.
- c. The junior price for the card is three hundred seventy five dollars plus tax (\$375+tax).
- d. The card is not valid on holidays.
- e. The purchase price for the card and program availability are subject to change annually.

18. Junior Eagle Pass (Annual 5-Course)

Golfers may obtain from the Salt Lake City Golf Division Administration Office a nontransferable season pass card called the Junior Eagle Pass to be presented at the golf course in lieu of payment for green fees. This season pass is subject to the following terms and conditions.

- a. The card may be used May 1 through August 31 at any time Monday through Thursday, Friday before Noon, and Saturday and Sunday after Noon at the following courses: Forest Dale, Glendale, Jordan River Par-3, Nibley Park, and Rose Park.
- b. The card may be used September 1 through April 30 after Noon Monday through Thursday and Saturday and Sunday.
- c. The card is not valid on Fridays.
- d. The card is valid for one (1) year from the date of purchase.
- e. The junior price for the card is four hundred ninety five dollars plus tax (\$495+tax).
- f. The card is not valid on holidays.
- g. The purchase price for the card and program availability are subject to change annually.

19. Junior Double Eagle Pass (Annual 9-Course)

Golfers may obtain from the Salt Lake City Golf Division Administration Office a nontransferable season pass card called the Junior Double Eagle Pass to be presented at the golf course in lieu of payment for green fees. This season pass is subject to the following terms and conditions.

- a. The card may be used May 1 through August 31 at any time Monday through Thursday, Friday before Noon, and Saturday and Sunday after Noon at the following courses: Bonneville, Forest Dale, Glendale, Jordan River Par-3, Mountain Dell Lake, Mountain Dell Canyon, Nibley Park, Rose Park, and Wingpointe.
- b. The card may be used September 1 through April 30 after Noon Monday through Thursday and Saturday and Sunday.
- c. The card is not valid on Fridays.
- d. The card is valid for one (1) year from the date of purchase.
- e. The junior price for the card is six hundred ninety five dollars plus tax (\$695+tax).
- f. The card is not valid on holidays.
- g. The purchase price for the card and program availability are subject to change annually.

20. Private Lesson Fees shall be established by the individual teacher.

GB.—Use Of Junior/Senior Discount Fees! Junior/senior discount fees provided for in this chapter may not be used Saturdays or Sundays, legal holidays, or for group reservation play.

D. Time For Twilight And Evening Play: Time for twilight and evening play at Mountain Dell shall be set each week on Monday morning by the golf professional or its designee.

E. Issuance: No season golf pass shall be issued without payment to the city of the appropriate fee listed in subsection A9 of this section.

C. F.—Definitions:

- 1. A "junior" is any person seventeen (17) years of age or younger.
- 2. A "senior" is any person sixty five (65) years of age or older.
- 3. The following are to be considered as defined "holidays": Memorial Day, Independence Day, Pioneer Day, and Labor Day.

GD. —Adjustment Of Fees:

The director of public services, with approval of the mayor, shall have the authority, at any time, to reduce the fees listed in this section for any city golf course, if the director deems it necessary to reduce fees in order to increase the use of the golf course.

SECTION 2. That Section 15.16.035 of the Salt Lake City Code be, and the

same hereby is, amended as follows:

15.16.035 Golf Courses-Group Reservations:

Reservations for exclusive use of a course <u>such as</u> for group play, <u>or</u>-tournaments, etc., <u>will shall</u> be allowed in accordance with the following guidelines:

A._--Payment:

Payment must be made at least ten (10) days in advance of:

- 1. A per person minimum tournament fee as follows:
- a. Eighteen (18) holes; ten dollars (\$10.00);
- b. Nine (9) holes, at all courses except Nibley park and Jordan River Ppar 35: five dollars (\$5.00); and
- c. Nine (9) holes at Nibley park and Jordan River Par-3:, three dollars (\$3.00).
- 2. All green fees and rentals, with no green fee discount allowed.

B. — Green Fees:

Appropriate gGreen fees as set forth in section 15.16.031 of this chapter, or its successor, shall be charged for each participant.

C.__Reasonable Regulations Set By Department Of Public Services:

The department of public services, with concurrence of the mayor, may set reasonable regulations with regard to:

- 1. How many days in advance of the date for which the facility is reserved that all reservation and/or green fees must be paid;
- 2. Amounts of refunds for cancellations and time in which cancellations must be made;
- 3. Rescheduling "rainouts";
- 4. Minimum and maximum numbers of golfers;
- 5. Cart reservations;
- 6. Minimum and maximum number of holes to be reserved for group play;
- 7. Dates and times for taking group reservations;
- 8. Golf courses for which group reservations may be made;
- 9. Costs for special services requested of the city over and above services normally provided; however, such costs shall reflect actual city costs, including overhead;
- 10. How many group reservations a person and/or group can make each-in a single calendar year;
- 11. How many group reservations a person can make per each-request;
- 12. Regulations for mMaking reservations by phone or in person.

D. Adjustment Of Fees:

The director of public services, with approval of the mayor, shall have the authority, at any time, to reduce the fees listed in this section for any city golf course, if the director deems it necessary to reduce fees in order to increase the use of the golf course.

SECTION 3. That Chapter 15.21 of the Salt Lake City Code, relating to the

Recreation Enterprise Fund be, and the same hereby is, repealed:

Chapter 15.21

RECREATION ENTERPRISE FUND

15.21.010 Purpose:

The purpose of this chapter is to establish the recreation enterprise fund and to transfer the golf enterprise fund into the recreation enterprise fund. (Ord. 44-92 § 1, 1992)

15.21.020 Recreation Enterprise Fund Operations:

The recreation enterprise fund shall account for operations of all city parks and recreation facilities excluding the Tracy aviary operations. (Ord. 44-92 § 1, 1992)

15.21.030 Transfor Of Golf Enterprise Fund:

The golf enterprise fund shall, from the effective date hereof, be transferred into the recreation enterprise fund and all of its operations, including fees charged pursuant to chapter 15.16 of this title, shall be accounted for in the recreation enterprise fund.
