

Board of Appeals & Examiners Appointment – Brenda Roberts

INTRODUCTION:

Mayor Anderson is recommending that Brenda Roberts, a resident of Salt Lake County, be appointed to the Board of Appeals & Examiners. If appointed, Ms. Roberts will serve a term extending through March 1, 2012 and she will replace June Wang, whose term has expired.

APPLICANT INFORMATION:

Ms. Roberts is employed at Intermountain Healthcare as a staff architect/project management and has been involved with Habitat for Humanity; Volunteer teacher for the Young Architect's Forum Build a City program for elementary schools; directed the CANstruction project for HKS Architects; active in the USGBC and has received the 2005 Faculty Award for Design Excellence, University of Utah. She is interested in developing architecture that is respectful to the environment, the constituents and in time.

CURRENT COMPOSITION OF BOARD OF APPEALS & EXAMINERS:

This five-member board is comprised of people who are qualified by experience and training to decide upon matters pertaining to building construction, housing and abatement codes and technical disciplines. Board members are not required to be City residents. Board members include David Richardson, District 3; George Smith, County resident; Brent Tippetts, District 7; and Cameron Wilson, District 5.

BOARD STRUCTURE:

The Board of Appeals and Examiners was created to provide reasonable interpretations of the City's "Buildings and Construction" ordinances, determine the suitability of alternate materials and methods of construction, hear and decide appeals of City administrative decisions and recommend new ordinances to the City Council. Any person aggrieved by a decision of the board may file a complaint with the court.
