# HOUSING PROGRAMS REPORT FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007

## QUARTER 3 (January 1, 2007 – March 31, 2007)

The Housing and Neighborhood Development Division's funding sources include the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), the HOME Program, Program Income from CDBG and HOME, Renter Rehab, Housing Trust Fund and Utah State Funding. Private funding sources include Wells Fargo Bank, GMAC and American Express.

The First Time Homebuyer Program, which uses HOME, CDBG, and private funding, has purchased and rehabilitated nine houses during the fiscal year. In addition, four additional houses are being rehabilitated, one house is available for sale, and two houses are under contract. HAND has also increased its efforts to purchase houses. HAND visited 95 houses during the quarter, made offers to purchase four, and was successful in obtaining one. HAND is currently negotiating to purchase four other properties. Plans are also complete for houses to be built on Gillespie and Colorado Streets. A request has also been submitted to Planning to create a flag lot on 1400 West. Once approved, two new houses will be built on the lot.
