BOARD STRUCTURE:

The Police Civilian Review Board is to provide civilian oversight of certain complaints and internal police investigations regarding conduct of the police. Audit and review cases in which it is claimed that a police officer used excessive force and other cases the board may request. There must be two members from each Council District on the board. Terms expire the 1st Monday in September after a three (3) year term.
