

Open Space Lands Advisory Board Appointment-Brad Bartholomew

INTRODUCTION:

Mayor Becker is recommending Brad Bartholomew be appointed to the Open Space Lands Advisory Board. If appointed Mr. Bartholomew will fill a vacancy and serve the term through March 1, 2013.

APPLICANT INFORMATION:

Brad Bartholomew resides in Salt Lake City, District One. He is currently employed with the State of Utah Department of Public Safety as a Mitigation Planner /Public Assistant Officer. Mr. Bartholomew is a member of the Rose Park Community Council and he feels as the need for open space continues he would consider it a privilege to help preserve that open space for Salt Lake City.

CURRENT COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD:

According to City ordinance, the Open Space Lands Advisory Board shall consist of nine members, each serving a four-year term. Members are to be selected from City residents in a manner that will provide balanced representation in terms of geographic, professional, neighborhood and community interests. Preference may be given to individuals with legal or land use experience. Board members include: Terry Becker, District 3; Sharen Hauri, District 5; Dale Lambert, District 7; John E. Norman, District 4; Donna Land Maldonado, District 6; Karen Shepherd, District 3; and Lorna Lee, District 6.

BOARD STRUCTURE:

Advise and make recommendations to City Administration and City Council on open lands preservation issues, projects and plans. Advise and make recommendations for the expenditure of open lands funds. Assist in preparation of annual budget for open lands. Make recommendations regarding any proposed construction or enhancement of open lands acquired with fund money. Assist City Administration with education or outreach efforts to foster public awareness and understanding of open lands program.
