
Recommendation from Administration – The Administration is recommending that a budget account be established for \$577,500 from the grant holding account. The City’s Administrative Services Sustainability Division received a 100% principal forgiveness loan of \$577,500 under the State of Utah Division of Water Quality, Water Quality Board, American Recovery & Reinvestment Act of 2009 Fund. In order to meet the State Recovery Act deadline of November 15, 2009, the construction must be underway or a contract awarded for the project.

Project Details – The funds will be used to restore and enhance the water quality and stream bank stability along the Jordan River. Upon Council approval, the City will enter into a contract with Salt Lake County, who will manage and complete the project construction at four sites along the Jordan River. The sites are as follows:

- 561 South 1100 West – East Bank
- 1175 South 1085 West – South Bank
- 1552 South 1200 West – South-west Bank
- 2050 South 1240 West – North Bank

Discussion:

The Management Services Sustainability Division has received a 100% principal forgiveness loan of \$577,500 under the State of Utah Division of Water Quality, Water Quality Board (WQB), American Recovery And Reinvestment Act of 2009 Fund. The project had been determined by the WQB to meet Nonpoint Source or wastewater project grant/loan consideration and is not economically feasible unless %100 principal forgiveness of the loan is provided.

The purpose of this funding is to restore and enhance the water quality and stream bank stability along the Jordan River at four sites. The sites include the east bank at 561 So. 1100 W.; the south bank at 1175 So. 1085 W.; the south-west bank at 1552 So. 1200 W.; and the north bank at 2050 So. 1240 W. The project will restore approximately 502 feet of bank along the Jordan River. The City will contract with the County who will manage and complete the project construction.

The Sustainability Division is requesting budget to accommodate the award in order to meet the November 15 requirement of the State Recovery Act, to have the construction contract awarded or be under construction.
