CURRENT COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD:

The Sorenson Multi Cultural Center Advisory Board is comprised of nine members. As required by resolution, five members will be appointed by Salt Lake City and four members will be appointed by Salt Lake County. A City representative will be an ex-officio member of the board. Salt Lake County members include; Bobbie Kirby, Alexander Ramos, Katherine Fife and Wilson Spörl.

BOARD STRUCTURE:

The Sorenson Multi Cultural Center Advisory Board was created in 2010 as per an Interlocal Agreement between Salt Lake City and Salt Lake County. The City and the County will establish a Citizen Advisory Board through the appointment process for each of their respective governmental entities, with formal approval of each board member appointment to be given by the legislative body of each party. The board shall establish bylaws regarding member's terms, meetings and other procedures.
